In **History** we will be finding out about the life of Roald Dahl, sequencing events in his life and using words and phrases about the passing of time.

We will ask questions and use different sources to find the answers, and make connections between Roald Dahl's life and his books.

RE

We will be finding out about Creation and how Christians believe that God created the universe and has a special relationship with humans. We will also think about how we need to care for the world because it belongs to God.

Our Maths objectives for the term:

Place value- count, read and write numbers in numerals and words; Make amounts using different objects;

Compare numbers; Solve problems.

Addition and Subtraction-

Yr1 learn number bonds to 10 and related subtraction facts;

Carry out addition and subtraction problems. Read and write +, -, = signs. Use objects and pictures to represent problems.

Yr2 Recall addition and subtraction facts to 20 and use to derive facts to 100;

Use objects and pictures to solve addition and subtraction problems; Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.

Mathletics homework will be set weekly.
